## From The Principal's Office & MSP



### Dear Parents,

Assalaam-o-Alaikum,

Last Sunday the MSP went for a picnic to the lake Wheeler, the weather was very nice ,they played many games & had much fun.

### Middle school program

Our (MSP) are learning about "Ibadat", and "Tazkit" in Islamic Study, and Quraan, they finished aya 20 from surat Alnabaa', memorization is optional.

Student learned the following:

1. Perfecting fasting: During Ramadan, we talked about the importance of living up to the challenge of perfecting Fasting not only physically, but also spiritually and socially. We examined that in depth, gave examples and ended with the notion of voluntary fasting.

2. Prophet Adam story: we learned about the general guidelines of the story and did some critical thinking skills like analyzing the characteristics of Satan that a lot of humans share with him and exhibit without knowing how displeasing that would be to Allah ( SWT) like vanity and disobedience and being cunning and hateful and far from humble. Also, we discussed in depth the gift of knowledge that God blessed Adam with and made him superior to other living creatures.

3. Loving the Prophet (Pbuh): Most important component of this presentation was loving him means following in his footsteps. I demonstrated to them through examples of his daily life occurrences, the different aspects that made him the exceptionally great person that he was, from cleanliness to modesty to intelligence in solving conflicts, into tolerance and forgiveness and sense of fairness. The highlight of the whole lecture was his Honesty and Truthfulness that set him aside from every body else during that time, and was the virtue that we all agreed at the end of class we should strive to follow.

4. Story of Prophet Nuh(Noah): we finished half of it last week and we will finish the second half this week.

The lesson to learn from the first half was the patience that the prophet had for trying for one thousand years without relenting to guide his people and be their savior until Allah (SWT), told him no more believers will be coming. the second moral of the lesson to learn is not to be affected by what people say to us sometimes if we know we are doing the right thing. That was demonstrated through examining the perseverance the prophet showed when every body laughed at him to build a ship where there is no body of water. and the last moral of the lesson was the virtue of obedience and how the prophet started building like he was ordered by his God without objecting or hesitation.

## Arabic Reading at Home

As you know, we all encourage our kids to learn and practice reading Arabic, memorizing Quran and get Islamic Education. The school time is not sufficient to get enough training for Arabic Reading. So, we need kids to practice reading at home.

It is not a difficult task if kids love to do it at home. All we need is to give them enough encouraging through rewards and prizes.

So, the Admin of ABY School decided to launch the Arabic Reading program in which kids will be rewarded for reading at home “any” Arabic material that families can provide them through hard copies, websites that contains Arabic Stories, reading from Quran book, Arabic newspapers, etc.

When the kid completes one hour of reading, the parents will sign a specific form “attached” and return it back to the school.
